

SAFETY NOTICE

Every person using the course, clubhouse and car park is responsible for their own safety.

Skipton Golf Club does not accept liability for any loss resulting from any cause suffered by any person using the course, clubhouse or car park



FOG & LIGHTNING: In the event of an electrical storm, suspend play immediately and take appropriate action. (Rule 6-8a applies). Do not tee off or continue play in fog/poor visibility when you cannot see the clear distance of your intended shot. All players use the course at their own risk.



GREENS STAFF: have priority at all times.

Players must always alert greens staff nearby or ahead when they are about to make a stroke which may endanger them.



THE COURSE, ITS STEPS AND SURFACES may be slippery when damp, wet or frozen. Golfers must wear appropriate footwear to meet the prevailing conditions. Wherever possible, keep to footpaths, steps and stiles. Take care on steep banks and when entering and leaving bunkers or ditches.



PUBLIC FOOTPATH: Be aware of and give priority to users of the public footpath, which crosses holes 1, 2, 3 and 4 and runs next to holes 10 and 11. Golfers must not tee-off until the footpath ahead of them is clear.



FIRST AID: First Aid box and AED defibrillator is available in the Clubhouse. Report all accidents to staff.

GOLFERS ARE REMINDED THAT THEY HAVE A DUTY OF CARE FOR THEMSELVES AND ALL OTHER COURSE USERS. FOLLOW BUGGY POLICY AND USE BUGGIES SAFELY



Players should not play until the players in front are out of range

Players should ensure that no one is standing close by or in a position to be hit by the club, the ball or any stones, pebbles, twigs or the like when they make a stroke or practice swing.

If a player plays a ball in a direction where there is a danger of hitting someone, they should immediately shout a warning. The traditional word of warning in such situations is "FORE!".

On hearing "FORE!", crouch, cover your head with your arms and count to 10.

GOLFERS ARE REMINDED OF THE NEED TO SHOUT "FORE" IF YOU CANNOT SEE THE FULL RANGE OF ANY WAYWARD SHOT ON TO ADJACENT FAIRWAYS

You are advised to carry a mobile phone to summon assistance in an emergency. Skipton GC does not accept responsibility for assisting injured persons off the course.

**RING 999 FOR AN AMBULANCE, CLEARLY STATING YOUR LOCATION.
AMBULANCE ACCESS IS VIA THE CAR PARK OR BRACKENLEY LANE (15th GREEN)**
